Review RFP for Platte-Republican Diversion Engineering Services: Thorburn reviewed the Request for Proposals for the Platte-Republican Diversion project, which NDNR will need to review also. Thorburn explained that CNPPID will be responsible for the engineering and construction just past Hwy 23. Any additional construction in Gosper County will be paid by TBNRD and in Furnas County by LRNRD. Additional construction could include protection of Rockies Express pipeline, rehabilitation of existing structures, upgrade of private stream crossings and potential erosion repair issues. The Request for Proposal includes survey work, assistance for dam rehab on Lyon Property and check structures. Thorburn is asking for approval to advertise for engineering services. The deadline for proposals is February 22, 2016. Thorburn mentioned there will be a Turkey Creek landowners meeting on December 14, 2015 and invited Directors to attend.

Moved by Garrelts, seconded by Bilka to allow staff to advertise for engineering services for the Platte-Republican Diversion Project. Motion carried.

Thorburn explained that saturated thickness differences were not as divergent as first thought. LBNRD's rules are based on a lower saturated thickness than reflected on their map. LBNRD requires flowmeters throughout the district. The two NRDs will be coordinating on the Little Blue Basin IMP, which could be used as a tool to coordinate groundwater management plans between the two districts.
