# DISCUSS OPTIONS FOR REPURPOSING CNPPID IRRIGATION RIGHTS FOR GROUNDWATER RECHARGE, INSTREAM FLOW

There was discussion about the Joint Platte Basin NRD meeting on January 5, 2016 in North Platte. The committee also directed Thorburn to set up a joint committee meeting with CNPPID Directors. Garrelts suggested NDNR attend to discuss the Platte Republican Diversion.

# INTERVIEW CANDIDATES FOR SUB-DISTRICT #3
