Consider Offering Backup Water System Operator Services to Villages in NRD: Thorburn explained that TBNRD could offer services of a backup water system operator to towns of less than five hundred (Loomis, Smithfield, Wilcox, Atlanta and Funk). Two technicians (Nott and VanEperen) would be trained for this purpose. Thorburn consulted with TBNRD's property insurance agent and employees would be covered under the current policy but suggested adding a "hold harmless" clause to the interlocal agreement. <u>Moved by Garrelts, seconded by Bilka to offer backup water system operator services to area villages in TBNRD. The total cost will be shared between NDNR (50%), LBNRD (25%) and TBNRD (25%). JEO will lead the meetings, take minutes, set the agenda, help stakeholders express views, and give technical support. Thorburn had Jeff Cox review the contract. Consider Financial Support for Platte Valley Weed Mgmt. Area: Thorburn explained that the Platte Valley Weed Management has been working for eight years to control noxious weeds, clearing channels and reduce consumption in the Platte River. The group has been funded by an NET grant but did not get funded this year. The organization could get funding from the state next year but is asking for funding from partners in the interim. TBNRD budgeted for the PVWM in previous years, but not for FY 2015-2016. Thorburn mentioned the project could be funded in the 2016-2017 Budget.
