CNPPID Groundwater Mound Study – Cory Steinke: Steinke explained CNPPID hired EA Engineering to do groundwater mound study to understand how the mound works using data and wells. Steinke stated that reduction in ET or crop use has a larger effect on the mound than reduction of diversions. The study indicated the mound is no longer increasing and might be at a tipping point.

Change Nitrogen Certification Card Requirement: Thorburn explained TBNRD has had groundwater quality management since 1989. Producers attend education to renew certification. Nitrogen cards have no purpose except to show the expiration date. Thorburn proposed discontinuing cards and notifying landowners when renewal is required. A card will be issued to a producer if requested. Moved by Reynolds, seconded by Winz to discontinue use of nitrogen management cards. Motion carried.

Engineering Study of Odessa IPA – Luke Dutcher, Miller & Associates: Luke Dutcher presented engineering study information on Odessa IPA showing suggested culvert sizes and drainage patterns. Thorburn presented information on the proposed cost of the project. The total cost is estimated \$75,376 (including engineering costs) plus interest of \$6,898. Resulting in a cost of \$5.66/acre or \$16.98/irrigated acre per year. Lee Wells expressed concern about changing the natural drainage to the north. Keith Stafford asked about culvert size concerning two and five year rain events. Garrelts asked that a postcard be sent to landowners informing them of updated costs and ask if they still favor the project.

Consider Ordering Appraisals for Kuehn and Agee Properties: Thorburn explained that TBNRD gets appraisals to facilitate negotiations. Appraisals do not lock in a price. If agreement isn't reached, TBNRD and landowners can individually choose an appraiser and a third appraiser, approved by both parties, is also chosen. If negotiations fail, eminent domain could be used.

Reynolds expressed concern about the cost of the project without having secured funding. Nelson commented that Kearney County landowners should receive some benefit from NRD tax dollars. There was discussion about changes to the 404 permitting process and how potential overappropriated status of the Little Blue Basin could affect the project.
