NARD REPORT

Reynolds explained that the three-cent levy will expire after FY 2017-2018 unless at least thirty-three senators vote to "unbracket" the measure. Reynolds said NARD is asking for support to keep the levy. Thorburn will submit supporting data to Edson.
