CALL TO ORDER

Review Proposed GW Management Rules Revisions: The planning committee recommended changes to the Groundwater Management Rules & Regulations and additional wording about pooling. Blankenau had no comments about pooling but had comments on other parts of the changes. Thorburn will work with Blankenau on the recommended changes.

Thorburn mentioned there will be a 2.5% reduction in health insurance rates for this fiscal year.

CNPPID: Ford reported Lake McConaughay is at elevation 3242.9 ft. and under 66% capacity and seven feet higher than this time last year.

NEW BUSINESS

Center Pivot Rainfall Shut-off Device – Joe Thorell: Rook Thorell, Joe Thorell and John VanZandt were present to provide information about a device that detects rainfall and automatically

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shuts a pivot off. It saves the producer from having to go to the field and shut the system down after a rain, which produces a water savings. Joe Thorell provided estimated water savings amounts. Thorburn asked the board to consider cost-sharing on the devices. The NSWCP cost-share docket includes rainfall shutoff equipment but there is no basis for average cost, so a maximum payout limit would need to be set. Thorell commented that a computer can shut off the pivot remotely but cannot detect rainfall on individual fields. The gauge will fit all makes and models of pivots. Joe Thorell asked the board to stop and see the gauge during the tour.

Apply for Grant from NDNR for Database Improvements: Thorburn explained to the board that revisions to TBNRD's databases are needed and NDNR is willing to provide a grant for the cost of the project (\$35,000). NDNR would like water use and certified acre data reporting modified.

Moved by Johnson, seconded by Larson to approve a grant application for database modification for water quantity data. Motion carried.
