He mentioned that the funds held with PRRIP can be used to acquire matching funds from NDNR, but a new contract is needed. Thorburn recommended leaving the funds as they are and potentially, using PRRIP funding for this year's budget and WCIP payments. Moved by Reynolds, seconded by Garrelts to accept Thorburn's recommendation to keep the J-2 Reregulation Reservoir funding in the same locations (CDARS and PRRIP) and renew the six-month CD.
