GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT

Groundwater, Certified Acre Transfers & WCIP – Thorburn presented three certified acre corrections (Dahlgren's, Inc., Phyllis Vandell and James B. Lueking Trust) from the county assessor. Affected landowners can appeal the corrections if they can prove that land was irrigated at least one year from 1997-2004 and three of the past five years.
