

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Association of Resources Districts sponsors a 457 Deferred Compensation Plan allowing Pre-Tax Elective Deferrals by participants.

WHEREAS, the NRD Benefits Committee reviewed and recommended the board approve adding a Roth Elective Deferral option to the Plan at their meeting on October 22, 2025.

WHEREAS, the recommendation was shared and approved by the NRD managers at the November 5, 2025, meeting.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the following <u>Contribution Types Section</u>, 5(b)(3), of the Nebraska Association of Resources Districts 457 Deferred Compensation Plan be amended as follows:

- 5. <u>CONTRIBUTION TYPES.</u>
- b. [X] **Pre-Tax Elective Deferrals.** The dollar or percentage amount by which each Participant has elected to reduce his/her Compensation, as provided in the Participant's Salary Reduction Agreement

And may Roth Elective Deferrals be made?

3. [X] Yes.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that Pre-Tax Elective Deferrals and Roth Elective Deferrals combined are subject to one single limit as defined by Code §402(g).

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, participants will be allowed to defer Pre-Tax Elective Deferrals or Roth Elective Deferrals or a combination of both, subject to the limit defined by Code §402(g).

RESOLVED, that the undersigned is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the Employer, all documents necessary to effect the changes authorized herein. Such resolution was approved by the NARD Board of Directors on November 10, 2025, to become effective January 1, 2026.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF WATER, ENERGY, AND ENVIRONMENT AND THE TRI-BASIN NATURAL RESOURCES DISTRICT FOR PLATTE RIVER BASIN STREAMGAGE CAMERAS

This Agreement is entered into by and between the Tri-Basin Natural Resources District ("TBNRD") and the State of Nebraska Department of Water, Energy, and Environment ("DWEE"), individually referred to as "Party" and collectively referred to as "Parties."

WHEREAS, the TBNRD and DWEE desire to establish a streamgaging camera station on the Platte River near Central City and add two streamgaging cameras at existing DWEE streamgaging stations in the Platte River Basin to aid in Hazard Mitigation at the sites listed below:

- 1. Platte River near Odessa
- 2. Platte River near Shelton

WHEREAS, the DWEE is authorized by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-227 to measure or cause to be measured the quantity of water flowing in the streams of the state; and

WHEREAS, the DWEE has the expertise necessary to make streamflow measurements, operating continuously recording streamgages, and timelapse stream cameras; and

NOW, THERFORE in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein the Parties agree as follows:

DWEE agrees to complete the work of adding cameras to the two existing streamgaging stations, establishing a camera only station on the Platte River near Central City, and paying for the annual cost of the cellular data subscriptions needed to transmit the photographs.

The TBNRD agrees to pay the costs for the establishment of the two streamgaging camera stations in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$5,000.00) and to pay the costs to establish a camera only station on the Platte River near Central City in an amount not to exceed Nine Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$9,000.00).

The TBNRD agrees to pay DWEE in an amount not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$15,000.00) for the operation and maintenance of the three stations for five years, the term of this Agreement, or until June 30, 2031. Reimbursement for operation and maintenance will begin July 1, 2026.

The TBNRD's total payment made to DWEE under this agreement shall not exceed Twenty-Nine Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$29,000.00). Both Parties agree on the projected budget for the establishment and operation and maintenance of the streamgage sites, which is attached

and incorporated into this Agreement by reference as Attachment A ("Budget for Project Development").

DWEE agrees to establish and operate cameras at the gaging stations at the agreed upon locations identified above for the duration of the Agreement. Photos will be collected each hour or more frequently and transmitted via cellular telemetry. Streamgaging data and/or photographs from the stations will be available on DWEE streamgaging website.

All field and analytical work of the Parties pertaining to this Agreement shall be made available to the other Party upon request, and if the work is not being carried out in a mutually satisfactory manner, either Party may terminate this Agreement upon ninety (90) days written notice to the other Party.

The effective date of this Agreement shall be the date that the last Party signs this Agreement. This Agreement may be terminated upon ninety (90) days' notice in writing by either Party for any reason. In the event of early termination, DWEE will retain any of the equipment installed during the establishment of these streamgages.

This Agreement may be amended only by written agreement mutually agreed upon and signed by both Parties.

DWEE will issue billings annually by October 1st. Payments of bills are due within sixty (60) days after the billing date. If not paid by the date due, interest will be charged at the rate of five percent (5%) for each thirty (30) day period, or portion thereof, that the payment is delayed beyond the due date.

AGREEMENT FOR OPERATATION OF AUGMENATION WELL

Pursuant to the Nebraska Interlocal Cooperation Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §13-801 et.seq., Tri-Basin Natural Resources District ("TBNRD") and Lower Republican Natural Resources District ("LRNRD"), both parties being political subdivisions of the State of Nebraska, hereby enter into this Agreement for Operation of Augmentation Well ("Agreement"), as follows:

- 1. WELL OPERATION: TBNRD has right and authority to operate an augmentation well registered with the Nebraska Department of Water Energy and Environment as G-179201, and located on land owned by Don Holen Farms, Ltd., hereinafter referred to as "Turkey Creek Augmentation Well." TBNRD agrees to operate Turkey Creek Augmentation Well to discharge groundwater produced from that well into Turkey Creek for augmentation purposes, a beneficial use. TBNRD shall operate the Turkey Creek Augmentation Well as practicable on the dates and times requested by LRNRD. TBNRD shall meter the well and determine the volume of water withdrawn. LRNRD shall have access to the Turkey Creek Augmentation Well at all hours of normal business operations to inspect the well and observe its operation.
- 2. NOTICE AND COMPENSATION: At the end of the Agreement Term, TBNRD shall provide notice and confirmation to LRNRD of the dates and times that the Turkey Creek Augmentation Well was in operation and the volume of water pumped. LRNRD shall compensate TBNRD for the cost of operation of the Turkey Creek Augmentation Well in the amount of \$_______. [done by the hour of operation or a flat fee?] LRNRD shall make payment to TBNRD on or before ________day of _______. [or did you want to invoice them?]
- 3. LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION: LRNRD assumes all responsibility and liability for any claims or causes of action that arise from the discharge of groundwater into Turkey Creek or impacts to surrounding groundwater wells allegedly caused by the operation of the Turkey Creek Augmentation Well ,and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless TBNRD for any and all such claims.

- 4. TERM: This Agreement shall terminate on December 31, 2026, unless the Parties hereto agree to extend this Agreement in writing. Any future extension/s shall be limited to one year.
- 5. APPLICABLE LAW AND SEVERABILITY: This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Nebraska. If for any reason whatsoever, any of the provisions of this Agreement shall be held or deemed invalid, unenforceable, or otherwise inoperative, the remaining sections shall continue in full force and effect as if agreed to without the inoperative provisions.
- 6. NO ASSIGNMENT: The rights and liabilities of the Parties under this Agreement may not be assigned by one party without the prior written consent of the other party to this Agreement.
